The major constructions include but are not limited to: Site Clearing, Mobilization, Traffic Control, 727.7 CY Roadway Excavation, 1,244 SY Milling 2" Depth, 123 SY Milling 4" Depth, 3,940 SY Milling 6" Depth, 123 SY HMA Pavement Repair, 1,011 TONS HMA19M64 Base Course 4" Thick, 655 TONS HMA9.5M64 Surface Course 4" Thick, 8 UNITS Reconstruct Inlet, 225 SY HMA Driveway 2" Thick, 231 SY Dense Graded Aggregate Base Course 4" Thick, 3,992 SY Dense Graded Aggregate Base Course 6" Thick, 100 LF Traffic Stripes Long Life Epoxy Resin 4", 1,230 LF Concrete Vertical Curb, Site Restoration and other items incidental and appurtenant thereto.

Drawings, specifications and forms of bid, contract and bond for the proposed work, prepared by Herbert J. Seeburger, P.E., Project Engineer, have been filed in the office of said Engineer at 4 AAA Drive, Suite 103, Hamilton Township, New Jersey, 08691 and may be inspected there by prospective bidders during business hours. Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the drawings and specifications by the Engineer, on proper notice and payment of cost of preparation in the amount of \$50.00.

Bids must be made on standard proposal forms, in the manner designated therein, and required by the specifications, must be enclosed in sealed envelopes, bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the project on the outside, addressed to the Borough of Hightstown, County of Mercer, New Jersey, and must be accompanied by a Non-Collusion Affidavit and a bid bond or certified check for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid, providing said check or bid bond need not be more than \$20,000.00 nor shall not be less than \$500.00, and be delivered at the place on or before the hour named above.

Bidders are required to conform to all provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, the Prevailing Wage Act, and the requirements of P.L.1975, C.127.
