

Hightstown Bridge Committee Agenda – april 16, 2013

Mason's Lodge – 7:30pm

Basic meeting notes:

1. Decision on railing due to questions from planning board on the two walk ways that run up from main street to the bridge.
 1. Team decided that if we can legally only have one railing against the rock wall we want that, if we have to have two railings then one on the wall and one on the side of the walk way not in the middle.
 1. Reasoning was due to both aesthetics and Public Works as they need 5' for snow plowing.
2. Funding: agreed to continue search for other funding options and Gary to introduce grant person to Pat/John so they can work together with Rush's office to find some opportunities.
3. Planning the project completion:
 1. Donation Plaque: agreed to continue the process
 2. When we get closer to completion we'll schedule the "grand opening"
 3. Funding of this will come from the current \$7k we still have in the bank, we agree to try and use the bonded funds for all future work so we don't have to raise any more money for the "celebration/plaque" work
4. Spec change requests
 1. Request that it be included in the specs that power conduit be installed prior to painting of the bridge so that there are no issue with rusting
 2. Request that prior to painting of Bridge the Borough can inspect the bridge to ensure satisfaction prior to painting.
