**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING BOARD OF HEALTH
CHAPTER IV, ENTITLED “RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT AND FOOD AND
BEVERAGE VENDING MACHINE CODE”, SECTION BH:4-2.4 , ENTITLED “FEES
FOR LICENSING RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS” OF THE BOARD OF
HEALTH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHTSTOWN, NEW JERSEY**

Summary: Waives fees associated with licensure or plan review for food banks, food pantry, mobile food pantry, or community dinner when owned and operated by a nonprofit association

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading at a meeting of the Borough Council Board of Health held on November 13, 2019 and ordered published in accordance with the law.
