**Public Comment:** Doug Mair suggested using the Hightstown incorporation date of 1853 on the banners if a date is to be used in the banner design. He mentioned that the HPC newsletter should be resurrected and sent out to all of Hightstown (not just the Historic District as it was in the past). Money is a factor as Mr. Musing pointed out – all of budget for 2017 is tied up in the banners so this item can be addressed next year when the budget resets or we find alternate ways to produce and distribute the newsletter. Doug Mair also asked if HPC could work with the Borough for rehabbing borough properties with some of the funds collected throughout the year in code enforcement fines.
