

**Where Does The Bus Go/What Is Bus Schedule?**

The Princeton Junction Shuttle commuter bus service, servicing East Windsor and Hightstown, provides service to and from the Princeton Junction Train Station during the morning and evening rush hours, Monday through Friday excluding holidays. Pick-ups and drop-offs will be made in the circular driveway in front of the Princeton Junction Station. Limited morning pickup service at the Princeton Junction Train Station with corresponding evening pickup service at two locations in East Windsor is also available. See schedule for details.

**What Is Fare?**

The cash fare is \$1 each way. Reduced fare tickets, 40 trips for \$32, are good indefinitely and may be ordered by mail from the Township or purchased from the driver. To order tickets, send your check made out to "East Windsor Township" in the amount of \$32 to: Manager's Office, 16 Lanning Boulevard, East Windsor, NJ 08520. Your tickets will be promptly mailed to you [along with a self-addressed envelope for ordering additional tickets]

**When Does Bus Operate?**

Shuttle service operates Monday through Friday, except on the following holidays: New Year's Day (Observed), President's Day, Memorial Day (Observed), July 4th (Observed), Labor Day, Thanksgiving, the day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve Day (December 24th) and Christmas Day (Observed).

The Shuttle Bus is lift equipped. For assistance, please ask the bus driver. Schedule information is available in larger print.

HOW TO USE THIS SCHEDULE:

- Choose the stop that is most conveniently located to your residence.
- Choose when you would like to arrive at the Princeton Junction Train Station and read left across the timetable to find when the bus will stop at your location.
- Service is also available from the Princeton Junction Train Station to points along Route 571 with return service in the evening. Consult the timetable for more details.
- Shading in the box indicates whether a stop is pickup only (Green), drop-off only (Red), or offers both pickup and drop-off service (Yellow).

# GENERAL INFORMATION AND POLICIES

## COMMUNITY SHUTTLE BUS

- Serves the general public in East Windsor and Hightstown.
- The bus is wheelchair accessible and the driver will assist any customer who may need assistance getting on or off the bus.
- Service animals, respirators, portable oxygen tanks, and personal aides are permissible.
- The bus service to local shopping centers and medical offices is available Monday through Friday.
- There is a minimal charge of 25 cents per trip, one way, to ride the bus.
- The bus is provided by appointment on a shared-ride basis using a small bus.
- Marketing materials in alternate formats are available upon request.
