What You Need to Know to Vote this November!
ELECTION DAY IS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3RD

REGISTER TO VOTE

Deadline to register is **October 13th**

Sign up online or find the paper form here: <https://voter.svrs.nj.gov/register>

Register by the deadline to receive a mail-in ballot or vote in-person for the 2020 election



VOTE BY MAIL

Every registered voter in New Jersey will receive a mail-in ballot

Mail-in ballots will be sent out **BY OCTOBER 5th**

Carefully follow the instructions that will come with the ballot **make sure your vote will count**

Use **BLUE** or **BLACK** ink ONLY
Red ink or pencil will NOT be accepted

Find instructional videos in **English** and **Spanish** at the Mercer County Clerk's website

Postage on the ballot is pre-paid--no need to buy a stamp!



CAST YOUR MAIL-IN VOTE

Your Options:

- 1) Drop your ballot in your regular mail box or post office
- 2) Drop off your ballot at the Mercer County Board of Elections Office:
[1440 Parkside Ave in Ewing until 8 pm on Election Day.](#)
- 3) Drop your sealed mail-in ballot in one of the County's 15 secure drop box placed throughout the county (at least 1 per municipality)
- 4) Drop off your sealed mail-in ballot at your local polling place on Election Day until 8 pm



VOTE IN-PERSON

You may still vote by provisional (paper) ballot on election day until 8:00 pm



TRACK YOUR VOTE

Track the progress of your mail-in ballot by going to nj.gov/state/elections/index.shtml and signing up for the "Track Your Ballot" feature.
