Please fill in your ballot and mail it or deposit it in the newly installed Board of Elections Vote-by-Mail Ballot Collection Box located at Hightstown Engine Co. No. 1 Firehouse. Note that if you go to the polls to vote on election day, you will be required to vote by provisional ballot (paper ballot). I strongly encourage you to fill out your Vote-by-Mail Ballot and submit it in the manner you find comfortable. Make your vote count in this election.

The various boards and committees of the Borough have been anxiously awaiting the opportunity to bring the community together with their anticipated events. The Emergency Management Coordinator is in the process of issuing requirements and guidelines to hold limited attendance events in the Borough. Watch the website for updated information and scheduling of events.

Please remain safe, limit travel, wash your hands, wear a mask when exiting your home, and maintain six-foot social distancing. By continuing to adhere to regulations, requirements, and recommendations put out by the various Health Departments/Officials and the CDC we will get through this together.
