Title: "ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$505,500 FROM FUNDS RECEIVED FROM FEMA FOR WATER AND SEWER UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF HIGHTSTOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF MERCER, NEW JERSEY."

Purpose: \$505,500 is hereby appropriated from funds received from FEMA for water and sewer utility improvements, including water treatment plant flood mitigation, the acquisition of a generator, construction, engineer design, soil boring, geotechnical and permit fees, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto and further including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.
