ORDINANCE STATEMENT AND SUMMARY

The ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Borough of Hightstown, in the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey on September 7, 2021 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. The summary of the terms of such ordinance follows:

Title: "ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(a) OF BOND ORDINANCE #2017-09 OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHTSTOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF MERCER, NEW JERSEY, FINALLY ADOPTED AUGUST 21, 2017 IN ORDER TO REPLACE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RETAINING WALL WITH THE REPLACEMENT OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS"

Purpose: To amend Section 3(a) of Bond Ordinance #2017-09 of the Borough of Hightstown, in the County of Mercer, New Jersey, finally adopted August 21, 2017 to read as follows:

"The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for the financing of which the bonds are to be issued is various capital improvements, including the replacement of curbs and sidewalks on Stockton Street (C.R. 571) between Oak Lane and the Borough limits to the west and improvements to First Avenue, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto."
