https://storymaps.arcgis.com/stories/a2899b9b102e461496c791d7bf2f7caa] Mercer County is doing an EXPO demonstration project is Trenton using funding from DVRPC near the Trenton Farmer's Market to manage truck traffic in a confined, oddly shaped block. Safe Routes to School Funding is being announced for this year - \$27 million, applications due in August. The DVRPC Safe Streets 4 All grant will include pass through grants to counties to support outreach to qualify municipalities for implementation funding. The Task Force will serve as the Local Outreach/Vision Zero Advisory Committee. The County continues to make progress on it's master plan update, including a crash analysis and an upcoming congestion analysis for the Mobility Element. They are also working on new land development standards. Progress reports were made on numerous projects throughout the county.

- Master Plan Reexamination. Deferred discussion of survey until June.
- Crosswalk, South Main-Leshin Update. Council voted to approve the new crosswalk, including a new ramp, high visibility pavement markings and installation of an RRFB flashing pedestrian activated signal.
