**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN REGULATIONS AND AMENDING
AND SUPPLEMENTING “THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE
BOROUGH OF HIGHTSTOWN,” IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH A NEW
CHAPTER 22 THEREOF TO BE KNOWN AS
“PRIVATELY-OWNED SALT STORAGE.”**

***Summary:** Establishes requirements for the storage of salt and other solid de-icing materials on properties not owned or operated by the Borough (privately-owned), including residences within the Borough to protect the environment, public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply.*
